HAS FOUGHT PAST THE TENTH ROUND 6 TIMES (Hatton past 10th 10 times)

12/6/08 KO 8 **OSCAR DELAHOYA** (sent delaHoya into retirement in what was originally perceived as a blowout win for Oscar. Outlanded the stagnant delaHoya 224-83 in total punches. Manny landed 59% of his power shots (195 of 333). Landed 45 of 76 power shots in round seven- Oscar landed 51 power shots all night!! Then outlanded Oscar 28-7 in eighth, as Golden Boy did not answer bell for ninth. Scoring thru 8: 80-71 2x & 79-72.)

6/28/08 KO 9 **DAVID DIAZ** (Pac Man, who won his first title at 112 lbs., moved up to lightweight to challenge for Diaz's title. Answered any questions about weight gain with sizzling performance. Landed **30% of his 88 punches thrown per round**. Also landed 37 % of his power shots (180 of 490- **54 power shots thrown per round**). The blitzed Diaz managed to land just 19% of his total punches. Manny landed 35 of 114 punches in round two; 32 of 84 in round five and 36 of 100 in round eight before the dropping Diaz at in the ninth. The fight was stopped at 2:24 of the ninth.)

3/15/08 W 12 (spl) **JM MARQUEZ** (rematch of controversial 5/8/04 draw. Dropped Marquez in round three. Overall, Marquez landed 172 of 511 (34%) total punches to 157 of 619 (25%) for Pac Man. Marquez also had a 130-114 edge in power connects, landing 42% to Manny's 37%. Scoring: 115-112 P; 114-113 P; 115-112 M.)

10/6/07 W 12 **MARCO A. BARRERA** (outlanded the passive Barrera 256-120 in total punches. Manny landed 37% of his 58 total punches thrown per round. Manny didn't have to step on the gas, as Barrera avg'd just 48 total punches thrown per round and landed just 81 power shots all night. Manny landed 54% of his power shots (176 of 325). Pac Man outlanded Barrera 309-172 in first fight. Scoring of rematch: 115-112; 118-109 2x.)



MANNY PACQUIAO NOTES

4/14/07 KO 8 **JORGE SOLIS** (Manny heated up in round six after getting cut over his left eye from an accidental clash of heads. Pac landed just 25% of his power shots over first five rounds- due to the awkward and not-busy (49 total punches thrown per round) style of Solis, 30-0-2. Pac Man landed 48% of his power shots in rounds six, seven and eight, including 51% in sixth (27 of 53). Solis was down twice in 8th, the second time for the count.)

11/18/06 KO 3 **ERIK MORALES** (blew away "El Terrible" in rubber match. Closed show by landing 51 of 71 power shots (72%) in third round. Outlanded Morales 73-25 in power shots in rounds two and three combined.)

7/2/06 W 12 **OSCAR LARIOS** (triumphant return to Philippines vs. former 122-lb. champ Larios successful- in same arena where 31 years earlier Muhammad Ali ko'd Joe Frazier in The Thrilla in Manilla. Larios held his own in early rounds, rocking Pac Man several times in 3rd. Late in 3rd a Pac right hook opened up Larios' left eye and the beat down was on. The game Larios was down in 7th & 12th. Scoring: 117-110; 118-108; 120-106.)

1/21/06 KO 10 **ERIK MORALES** (Pac Man sought revenge from decision loss to El Terrible 10 months earlier. Morales 6-5 favorite. First five rounds replay of first fight, as Morales controlled fight with jab and had a 107-84 edge in total connects. Morales up by a point on 2 judges cards thru 5 and ahead by 3 points on third card. Pac Man did invest in the body early and that attack began paying dividends in the sixth, as Manny outlanded Morales 32-8 in power shots. The route was on. Morales, unable to hold off Pacquiao any longer, landed just 20 jabs over the last 4 rounds. He was down in the 9th, before the end came at 2:33 of the 10th after Manny had a 18-5 edge in power connects in 10th and a 103-45 edge in power connects after 5th round. Morales was stopped for the first time in his 52-fight, nearly 14-yr. career.)

9/10/05 KO 6 **HECTOR VELAZQUEZ** (showcased on undercard of Morales-Raheem. Held up his end of the deal, blowing away Velazquez, 42-10-2, in 6th round. Outlanded Velazquez 130-59 over last 4 rounds, averaging 83 punches thrown. Closed show by landing 40 of 98 in 6th, including 37 of 85 power shots.)

3/19/05 L 12 **ERIK MORALES** (pick'em fight, controlled by naturally bigger man Morales, who landed 265 of 714 (37%) total punches (60 per round) to 217 of 894 (24%-75 per round) for Pac Man. Morales showed his versatility, outjabbing the southpaw 96-34, averaging 25 per round to 29 per round for Pac, who landed just 10%. Morales also landed 41% of his power shots (169 of 411) to 183 of 545 (34%) for Pac, who was cut badly over right eye in 5th round. Morales outlanded Pac 120-82 in rounds 4 thru 8, winning 4 of those 5 frames on all cards. Morales, wanting to add some "flavor" to his performance, even turned southpaw in round 12 and landed 25 of 69 total punches. Pac had his best round in the 12th, landing 31 of 99 total punches, including 25 of 62 power shots. Too little too late, as the scorecards read 115-113 Morales across the board.)



5/8/04 D 12 **JUAN MANUEL MARQUEZ** (dropped Marquez three times in 1st round. Judges Jutras (115-110 M) and John Stewart (115-110 P) scored that round 10-6. Other Burt Clements (113-113) scored it 10-7, unaware he could have went 10-6. It cost Pacquiao a majority decision win. Pac Man avg'd 75 punches in rounds 1 & 2-then fought at a more Marquez-like pace of 40 per round over next 10 rounds-a credit to Marquez. Jutras, who scored 115-110 Marquez, gave Marquez the second round despite landing just 8 of 45 total punches to 18 of 77 for Pacquiao. Overall Pac Man went 148 of 639 (23%) to 158 of 547 (29%) for Marquez, who had a 122-100 edge in power connects, throwing 339 to Pac's 231.)

11/15/03 KO 11 **MARCO A. BARRERA** (4-1 'dog Pac Man devoured Barrera, outlanding JC Superstar 309-172 in total punches. Landed 45% of his power punches. Applied constant pressure, *averaging 76 punches per round, landing 30 or more punches in 6 of 11 rounds.* Overall went 309 of 838 (37%) to 172 of 547 (31%) for Barrera. Kennedy McKinney landed 359 punches vs. Barrera, the most landed vs. Marco in 18 of his fights tracked by CompuBox. Manny down for questionable knockdown in 1st. Barrera down in 3rd and 11th. Scoring thru 10 rounds: 97-90; 97-90; 97-89.)

FORMER TWO-TIME JUNIOR WELTERWEIGHT CHAMP ('05 & '07) & WELTERWEIGHT CHAMP ('07) Also held wbu jr. welter title from '01-'04, successfully defending it 15 times.)

HAS FOUGHT 9 CURRENT OR PAST WORLD CHAMPS (8-1, 5 ko's vs. 9 champs)

46 FIGHTS HAVE LASTED 274 ROUNDS AND AVERAGED 6.0 ROUNDS

HAS 32 KO'S IN 46 FIGHTS (70%)

HAS 5 FIRST ROUND KO'S (in first 9 fights)

HAS 2 KO'S PAST THE 9TH ROUND

11/22/08 KO 11 **PAULIE MALIGNAGGI** (too strong for Paulie. Landed 24% of his 52 punches thrown per round, but did outland Paulie 99-25 in power shots. Landed a big right hand in 2nd round that seemed to take the fight out of Malignaggi. Paulie's corner stopped the fight :48 into the 11th after several flush right hands. Scoring thru 10: 99-91 3x.)

5/24/08 W 12 **JUAN LAZCANO** (Returned from Mayweather ko loss vs. Lazcano, who'd been inactive for 15 months after losing decision to Vivian Harris. As expected, Hatton was busier, as Lazcano threw one punch at-a time. *Lazcano rocked Hatton with left hook in 8th round and had him holding on for dear life in 10th after landing a four-punch combination. Homer referee, Howard Foster, saved Hatton from possibly being knocked out in the tenth round by stopping the action to warn Lazcano for a phantom foul. He even instructed Hatton's corner to tie his shoelaces for another 20 seconds to recover.* Scoring: 120-110 H; 120-108 H; 118-110 H.)

12/8/07 KO by 10 **FLOYD MAYWEATHER** (Hatton had his moments early as the aggressor, before Mayweather began timing his charges. Hatton cut over right eye in 3rd. Hatton had his best round in the 5th, landing 13 of 54 total punches. He landed in single digits in connects in EVERY other round. Mayweather outlanded Hatton 47-10 in rounds 8 & 9 before dropping him with a "check hook" in the 10th. A final Mayweather flurry ended the fight at 1:35 of the 10th. Overall, Hatton went 63 of 372 (17%-40 thrown per round) to 129 of 329 (39%) for Mayweather, who had a 100-52 edge in power punches landed. Scoring thru 9: 89-81 M 2x & 88-82 M.)

6/23/07 KO 4 **JOSE LUIS CASTILLO** (purified some of the stench left behind from his lack luster performance vs. Urango with a one-punch (left hook to liver) ko of faded Castillo at 2:16 of round four. Crowd of 13,000 in attendance, an estimated 11,000 of which were Hatton fans from U.K. First two rounds fought on the inside, with Hatton holding a 38-18 edge in power connects, throwing 111 power shots among his 123 total punches thrown. Third round closer, with Hatton holding a 22-18 edge in power connects. Overall, Hatton landed 81 of 220 total punches (37%-60 thrown per round) to 58 of 192 (30%) for Castillo. Hatton had a 76-47 edge in power connects, throwing 201 to Castillo's 151.)



RICKY HATTON NOTES

1/20/07 W 12 **JUAN URANGO** (won Urango's version of 140 lb title with lackluster performance. Landed 34% of his 63 punches thrown per round. Did more clinching than fighting after Urango landed series of body shots in 5th round. Urango landed 23 of 52 power shots in 5th round, then landed an average of 10 power shots per round the rest of fight, throwing 35 per round. ***Hatton avg'd just 49 total punches thrown per round over last 4 rounds.*** Scoring: 119-109 3x.)

5/13/06 W 12 **LUIS COLLAZO** (moved to welterweight and was nearly ko'd in 12th by southpaw Collazo, who had just 12 ko's in 28 fights. Dropped Collazo :15 into 1st round and cut Collazo's lip in 2nd. Landed 259 of 741 (35%) to 213 of 712 (30%) for Collazo. Hatton had 254-167 edge in power connects, landing 40% to 35% for Collazo. Avg'd 62 punches per round, 53 of which were power shots. Scoring: 115-112 2x & 114-113.)

11/26/05 KO 9 **CARLOS MAUSSA** (cut over left eye in first round of first title defense. Also cut in corner of right eye in 3rd. Continued to pressure awkward Maussa, throwing 41 power shots per round among his 55 punches per round. Maussa, who ko'd Vivian Harris in June to win a 140-lb title, had his moments, landing 30% of his power shots. Maussa was also destroyed by Miguel Cotto in 8 rounds in December of '03. Left hook put Maussa down for a nine-count before his corner entered ring. Scoring thru 8: 80-72; 79-73; 78-74.)

6/4/05 KO 11 **KOSTA TSZYU** (upset 31-1 Tszyu, who hadn't lost since '97 ko to Vince Phillips as 22,000 packed the MEN Arena in Manchester. Won a version of 140-lb title. Swarmed Tszyu, 35, all night, throwing 49 power shots per round among his 59 punches per round, landing 32%. Tszyu managed to land 32% of his 56 punches per round and 35% of his power shots. Scoring thru 11: 105-104; 106-103; 107-102.)
